Classroom Mahagement

- During the first week of school, students will be <u>collaborating</u> with each other and Ms. Chris to set official <u>classroom rules and expectations</u>. When this is complete she will send home a <u>contract</u> for your child and you to sign to confirm <u>understanding and agreeance</u>.
- I work with a <u>color system</u> to help manage the classroom and this system will work based off of the class rules we create.

 initial on them every night.
- <u>Positive and Negative Consequences</u> will result based on your child's personal choices and their final placement each day on this chart.
